  - Answer questions (4-5 minutes)

#### **English Section**

- 75 Questions
- 45 Minutes
- Testable items
  - Punctuation, grammar, and syntax
  - Audience, purpose, organization, style
- Not Testable Items
  - Spelling and vocabulary
- Pay attention to style and rhetoric of passage
  - How does question fit into context of passage?

#### **English Section**

#### Know the situation

- Pay attention to style and context and theme
- How does question fit into the bigger picture?
- Tone = Author's attitude towards the subject

#### Do easiest questions first

- Pile up points and save time
- Finish each section before moving to the next

#### **English Section**

- Choosing an answer
  - Listen to the sound of the options
  - Eliminate long responses we want precision
  - Eliminate contradictory responses
  - Substitute responses into the sentence
- Terms to review
  - Appositive, antecedent, active voice, idiom, clauses, modifier, audience, purpose, rhetoric, tone
