

Lobotomy

- Neural passages from the front of brain are surgically separated from the back of brain
- Two Shocks to Head to sedate
- Roll Back Eyelids
- Insert device—2/3 the size of a pencil— through the upper eyelid into the patient's head
- Tap device with hammer into patient's head/frontal lobe
- Manipulate device back and forth in a swiping motion within head



Frontal Lobe


- **Frontal Lobe** - Front part of the brain; involved in planning, organizing, **problem solving, selective attention, personality** and a variety of "higher cognitive functions" including **behavior and emotions**.
- The anterior (front) portion of the frontal lobe is called the prefrontal cortex. It is very important for the "higher cognitive functions" and the **determination of the personality**.
- The posterior (back) of the frontal lobe consists of the **premotor and motor areas**. Nerve cells that produce movement are located in the motor areas. The premotor areas serve to modify **movements**.

The Frontal lobe is considered the emotional control center and the home of our personality.

The frontal lobe controls higher level thinking:

- Reasoning
- Planning
- Language
- Long-term Memory
- Impulse control
- Problem Solving
- Emotions
- Judgment
- Motor Function
- Initiation
- Social/ Sexual Behavior

The Controls of The Combine

- Strict routines and schedules = submission
- Closed doors for punishments and insinuations not threats = fear of unknown – power of imagination
- Log book and opened letters = paranoia – censored communication — atmosphere of being watching
- Therapy Session = pecking party – victimization phenomenon and self survival (attack or be attacked)
- Hospital Jargon = placating — another language with no access – placate by intimidating, disorienting, overwhelming
